WISE speaks to college STEM interns

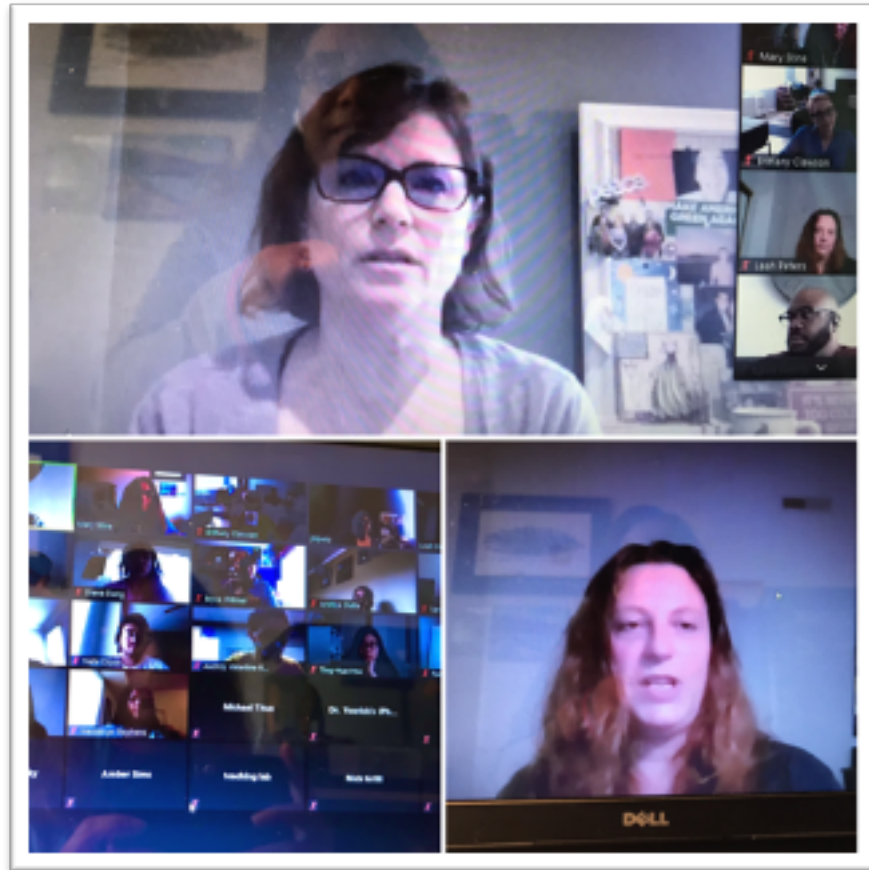
