## WHO CAN APPLY:

Eligible students include those majoring or minoring in safety-related disciplines such as engineering, environmental science, chemistry and chemistry-related sciences, health sciences, kinesiology, nursing, occupational safety and health, psychology, and other science-based programs, are currently enrolled at an accredited college or university with an anticipated graduation date. *Students enrolled in workshops, continuing education, or safety training courses or programs are not eligible.*

## HOW TO APPLY:

Full time students enrolled in an EHS, science, safety, or environmental program Interested in an EHS, occupational health, or environmental career with a minimum GPA of at least 2.5 out of 4.0  
Submit the following to [scholarship@sj.assp.org](mailto:scholarship@sj.assp.org)

- Cover Letter that **includes:** (1) what you have learned or experienced about the EHS, Occupational Health, or the Environmental fields and (2) how you plan to use this experience or education in your chosen career.
- University or College Transcript (current unofficial transcripts accepted)
- One Letter of recommendation (ASSP member, faculty, or professional reference preferred)
- A resume or description of work experience/internships – include participation in student/professional organizations, leadership roles, extracurricular activities, community services, and/or awards

**NOTE:** Seniors graduating in or before June 2026 are NOT eligible unless accepted into a graduate program. An acceptance letter or similar verification is required.
